# LECTURE TWO: COMPARE AND CONTRAST PARAGRAPH

#### 1. WHAT IS A PARAHRAPH?

A paragraph refers to a set of interrelated sentences which has been arranged to serve one given topic, or extending one single idea. Paragraphs do need be aware of the importance of certain aspects of connectors, punctuation, and appropriate lexis and steams of ideas.

#### 2. COMPARISON & CONTRAST PARAGRAPH

This type of paragraphs deals with similarities and differences between two products, ideas, or systems. It follows the following order:

- **1. Topic sentence**: refers to the first sentence which holds the whole idea of the paragraph. It helps the reader to have a general idea about the coming ideas in paragraphs.
- **2. Supporting sentences**: refers to what supports the topic sentences, it can be appeared as examples, statistics, explanations, or any other details.
- **3. Concluding sentence**: refers to the last sentence that is used to end up the paragraph, it sums up all what is discussed in previous sentences.

#### 3. CONNECTORS

## Connectors That Show Comparison between Sentences

COMPARISON	EXAMPLES	
In addition, subject + verb.	Both Red Beauty and Midnight Dream roses are known for the size of their blooms, their color, and their fragrance. In addition, they are easy to grow.  The Midnight Dream rose won awards in local contests last year.  Similarly, the Red Beauty rose was singled out for its beauty.

#### **SAMPLE**

The United States of America is named as the top economic power in 21 of the 34 countries surveyed, **while** China is considered the top economy in 12. **Although** most non- European countries see the United States as the world's leading economic power, those in Europe tend to name China. For example, in the Asia- Pacific countries surveyed, a median of 46% say the U.S is the top economy; **whereas**, a 25% median say the same about china. Across many of these countries, too, there is little ambiguity about which country is dominant, with double-digit differences between the shares who

choose the U.S. and who choose China as the top economy. This is most extreme in South Korea, where there is a 70 percentage point difference between those who cite American economic supremacy (82%) and Chinese dominance (12%). South Koreans are alike to name the U.S as the world's leading economy. However, Indonesians and Australians stand out for being more likely to choose China as the leading economy. To sum up, the United States and China do compete each other in the whole world market to get the name of the dominant and leading economic power in a wide range of countries.
