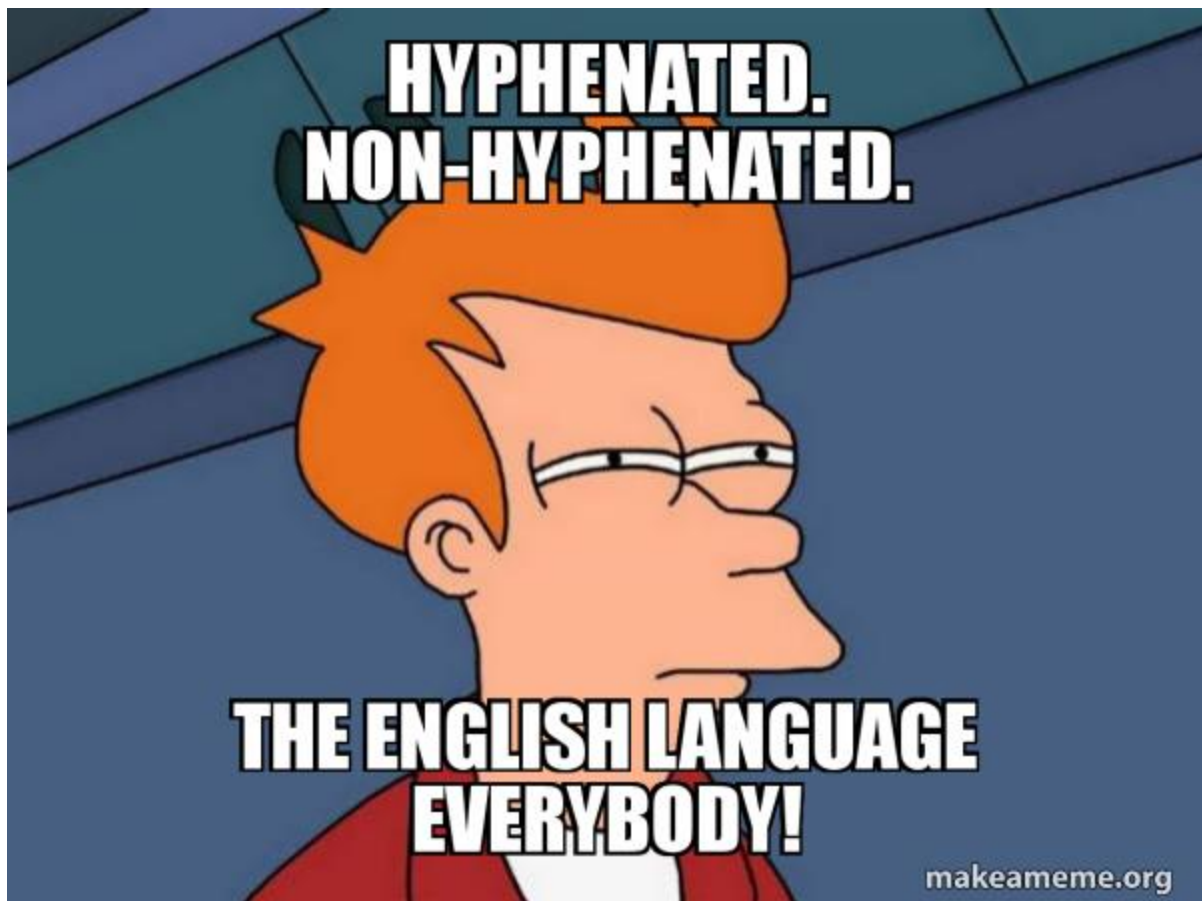
- The main affect of physical contexts on learners' intrinsic motivation.
