Lecture 06: **Describing a product**

When describing a product, you will usually use adjectives. You can use more that one adjective, but they must be in a particular order.

key language :adjective order

The meaning of an adjective decides its order in a sentence. Opinions come first, followed by different types of facts.

Eg: look at this fantastic huge plastic model!

Fantastic: opinion adjective

Huge: fact adjective, size

Plastic model: noun, material
