The gifted person acquires the thing himself or his agent.

If he is a minor or under custody, the possession shall be assumed by his legal representative.

Parents have the right to take back the gift from their boy, regardless of his age, except in the following cases:

If the gift is for the sake of marriage to the gifted one;

If the gift is to guarantee a loan or pay off a debt;

If the gifted person disposes of the thing gifted by selling, donating it, or introducing something that changes its nature.

A gift for the purpose of public benefit is irreversible.
